Marlpit Community Garden

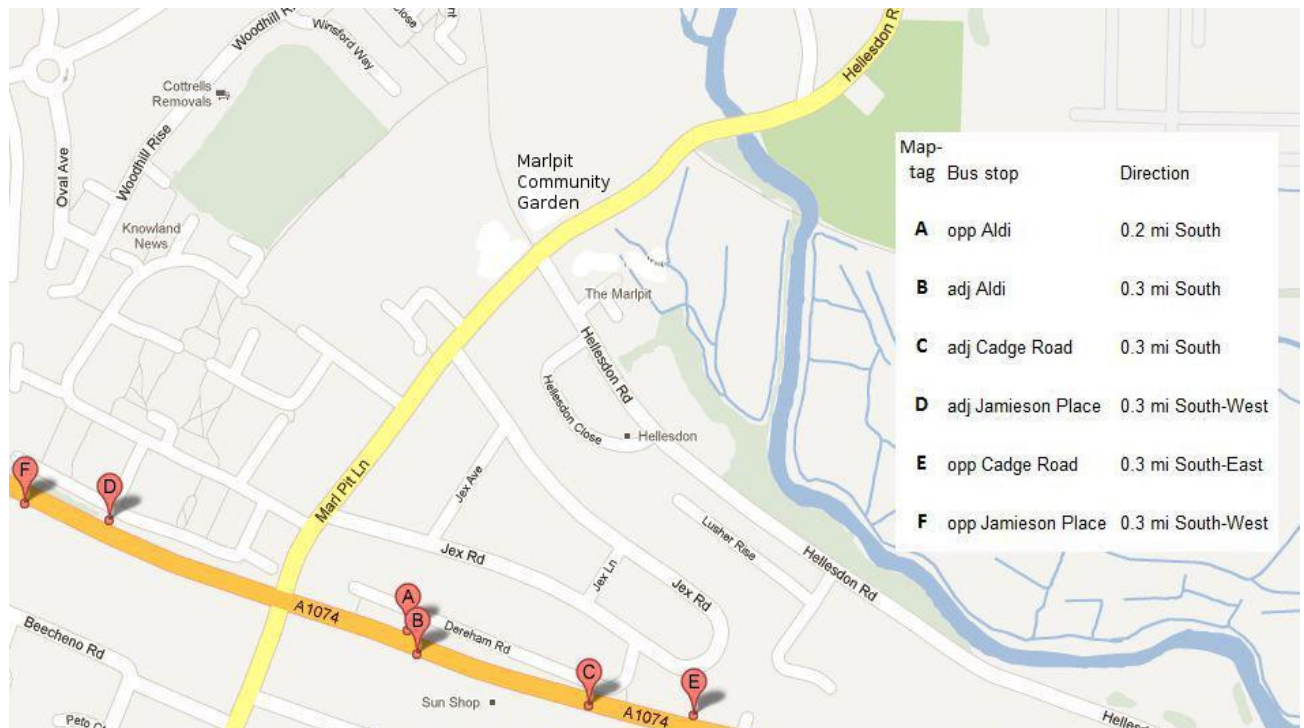
Marlpit Community Garden, Norwich is located at the junction of Hellesdon Road and Marlpit Lane and adjacent to the Marriot's Way cycle path (Sustrans National Route 1). The post code is NR5 8XN.

It is accessible on foot and cycle from various locations in Norwich. To plan your walking trip visit www.walkit.com/norwich. Cycling is encouraged and the new Norwich cycle plan is available at this link <http://www.norwich.gov.uk/TransportAndStreets/Transport/Pages/Cycling.aspx>

If you wish to travel by bicycle you can securely lock your bike at our cycle park at the entrance to the site which is clearly marked. The green travel map for Norwich will help you plan your journey or alternatively you could also visit www.cyclestreets.net.

The nearest bus stop to Marlpit Community Garden is outside Aldi supermarket on the Dereham Road and is an 11 minute walk. A map showing the nearest stops is below. Information for Members, Staff and Visitors

The train station is approximately 40 minutes away, we can then be reached by using the bus and/ or walking. Please go to www.travelineeastanglia.org.uk to plan your journey.

Should you need to drive to our site because you have a disability, there are four bays available on site. Please let us know in advance that you require a parking space.

Individuals applying for a plot in the Marlpit Community Garden will have to sign an agreement promising not to travel to the Garden by car. Any individual who regularly flouts the agreement will lose their membership. It is the policy of the organisation to allocate plots only to those people who live within walking distance (20-25 minutes' walk) to minimise the use of cars to the Community Garden.

Schools and community groups applying for a plot will be required to supply details of their travel plan in advance, for example, how many people travelling, when and how. There will be a mini-bus drop-off facility on site.
